



Job Description for Pastor of Mission and Outreach

1. Create a culture of outreach in the congregation that emphasizes how mission is *with* people, rather than *to* or *for* them. This will involve providing pastoral leadership through preaching and teaching that inspires a deeper understanding of God's mission.
2. Network broadly throughout the community with faith communities, non-profit organizations, and government leaders to envision unique outreach efforts that meet real needs and demonstrate God's love.
3. Equip and mobilize church members of all ages to actively engage in hands-on mission and outreach opportunities, both locally and globally. (This will involve contributing to some administrative support for existing church programs.)
4. Collaborate with staff and ministry teams to integrate mission-minded practices into worship, discipleship, and fellowship, shaping the church's identity as a servant community.
5. Manage a budget for projects that, in addition to sending money to other organizations, also creates new ministry opportunities for OUMC members to be involved in. This may involved spearheading some strategic fundraising initiatives.

Qualifications

- United Methodists are especially encouraged to apply.
- A Masters degree in an area related to theology or ministry is preferred.



- Candidates should demonstrate a passion for mission and outreach, bringing experience with churches or non-profits, either as a staff member, lay person, or volunteer.
